DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SITUATION	APPLICATION RATE	CRITICAL COMMENTS
To identify broadacre spray swath width	1 part foam to 100 parts of water	Use at this rate for boom spray foam marking in foam generators. Under normal weather conditions (up to 35°C) the foam should remain visible on the ground for about 2 hours. The life span will be affected by hot dry weather conditions, use higher rate in these conditions.
As above but at temperatures above 35°C	1 part foam to 50-60 parts of water

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of reach of children.

Store in the closed original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and bury empty containers in a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots. Empty containers and product should not be burnt.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When using the product, wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist (or equivalent clothing), elbow length PVC/rubber gloves and face shield or goggles. If product on skin, immediately wash area with soap and water. If product in eyes, wash out immediately with water.
